NAOMI FEIL

Naomi Feil, M.S.W., A.C.S.W., is the developer of Validation. She was born in Munich in 1932 and grew up in the Montefiore Home for the Aged in Cleveland Ohio, Where her father was the administrator and her mother, the head of the Social Service Department. After graduating with a Masters degree in Social Work from Columbia University in New York, she began working with the elderly. In 1982 she published her first book, Validation: The Feil Method. Since 1989 she has toured Europe 3 times a year offering workshops in Validation to participants in Germany, the Netherlands, Scandinavia, France, Belgum, Italy, Great Britain, and Austria. The Validation is now recognized as an important method of non- pharmacological approach to working with people with Alzheimer's disease.

VICKI de KLERK - RUBIN

Vicki de Klerk - Rubin, was born in New York and lives in Holland. She is Validation Master, Executive Director of Validation® Training Institute, a fundamental point of reference for all AVO(Authorized Validation Organization) of Europe.

She is a registered nurse and holds a degree in Arts from Boston University and a Master of Business Administration from Fordham University.

She oversaw the revision of the book Validation, The Feil Method, She is the author of numerous articles and produced a great deal of more specific programs for authorized courses, thereby contributing to maintaining the integrity of the method.

THE VALIDATION METHOD

The Validation method is a method of communication to facilitate the relationship with very old disoriented people. The Validation® is practiced through a non-judgmental attitude and open to the acknowledgement of emotions and universal needs. The basic component is that an emotion recognized and validated by person of trust, decreases in intensity and is less painful; people communicate more and are less locked up in themselves, thereby slowing transition into the progressive phases of disorientation.

Through empathetic listening, using eye contact and touch, Validation practitioners build mutual respect and trust with very old disoriented people.
