Delusions, Hallucinations, and Validation by Nancy Brown

Nancy Brown, a Certified Validation Teacher and VTI's Deputy Director for Communications, shares an article on the "mind's eye", a phenomenon that explains how the human brain can be stimulated to recreate vivid sensory images—visual, auditory, and kinesthetic memories—both positive and negative.

In her article, Nancy provides compelling anecdotes of real patients, and decouples the assumptions we make about hallucinations:

"For the majority of persons with dementia, they, too, are not delusional. They, too, engage their "mind's eye" in eidetic imagery. However, because of their cognitive impairment, they do not need to close their eyes—what they see is very real. They see an incident, event, or experience an emotion as if it is still present, not as if they are recalling a past event. The vividness of the image has meaning; it is healthy and releasing. It is their reality."
