Recap of Gerontological Society of America in November 2022 at the GSA 2022 Scientific Conference

Dr. Harvey Sterns, long-time VTI Board member and professor emeritus of psychology at

University of Akron (just two of his many activities) presented our recent research at the Gerontological Society of America Scientific Conference this past November in Indianapolis. Our study looked at the effectiveness of the 6 Skill Building Blocks, a totally online, asynchronous training in basic Validation skills. "This is a great way to onboard new staff or refresh person-centered skills."

VTI was proud to show the positive results of our small research project. Techniques taught through Skill Building Blocks proved to be relevant to the learners' life experience. There was effective retention and transfer of skills, and the training proved to be motivating for continued application in the real world.
