



Spotlight on Dr. Marina Kojer: Pioneer of Validation in Long-term Care

VTI proudly celebrates the groundbreaking work of Dr. Marina Kojer, a Validation pioneer who began using the method in 1997 as chief doctor in Europe's largest long-term care home. Integrating person-centered care into daily practice, Dr. Kojer transformed dementia care, creating trust and connection with her patients while improving diagnostic and therapeutic outcomes. Dr. Martina Schmidl, a senior physician under Dr. Kojer, beautifully captured the power of Validation in her chapter, *The Importance of Validation for the Doctor*, from the book *Old*, *Sick*, *and Confused* (4th edition). She shares how Validation allowed her to reduce stress, achieve better diagnostic clarity, and experience profound, rewarding relationships with her patients.

"Since I started approaching patients in a validating way, it became natural for them to greet me with a smile, hold my hand, and thank me for respecting and understanding them," Dr. Schmidl reflects.

AVO Feature: Crosslands' Journey with the Validation

Method

Kendal~Crosslands Communities has embraced the Validation method as a cornerstone of its dementia care approach, reflecting its core values of belonging and support. Starting in 2022, the Crosslands Health Center partnered with the Validation Training Institute (VTI) to introduce staff and residents to the Naomi Feil Validation method, offering classes and certifications for staff to deepen their expertise.

In November 2024, Crosslands achieved a major milestone by becoming an Authorized Validation Organization (AVO), joining an elite group of 28 organizations in 14 countries. With 10 Certified Validation Workers and three Certified Group Leaders, Crosslands continues to offer group validation sessions, fostering connection, expression, and enhanced relationships between residents and caregivers.
